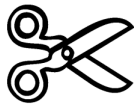




BACK 2 SCHOOL

St. Michael School has been working closely with the Superintendent, principals and Back to School Task Force for the Diocese of Saginaw to put together a plan for returning to school in the fall. We will be providing In-Person Learning in all grades. Middle School grades will remain in their classrooms throughout the day and teachers will move from classroom to classroom. Teachers will be incorporating online platforms in their classrooms to provide a smooth transition between In-Person and Virtual Learning if we were to move to Phase 3, 2, or 1.

Below is an outline of our plan for each phase. We will continue providing information in the coming days and weeks.



PHASES 1-3

During phases 1-3, all schools are closed for In-Person Instruction. Remote instruction will occur during this time.



PHASE 4

During Phase 4, St. Michael School will be open for In-Person Instruction while following strict safety protocols where necessary.



PHASE 5

During Phase 5, St. Michael School will be open for In-Person Instruction with modifications to accommodate safety protocols.
